Last year we promoted three D-37 events, Off-road - the Hungry Valley Qualifier held the 3rd Sunday in May, the third race (end of June) of the D-37 Southern California MX Series at Quail Canyon MX track, and the D-37 VCMC Casa Pacifica Dual Sport Ride.

We have approximately 35-70 members and are looking for new members all the time. Our group riding consists mostly of; trail riding, Dual Sport riding, racing the D-37 Big 6 GP series, Motocross (CRC, OTHG, & OTMX) and enduro and desert racing. Several members have street bikes and we also do some street rides.

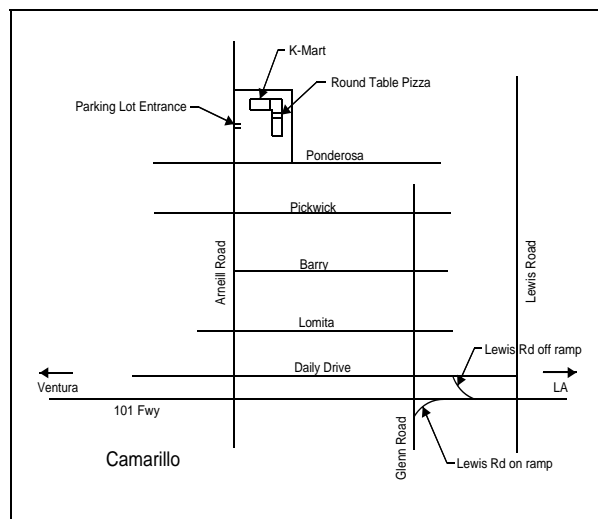
